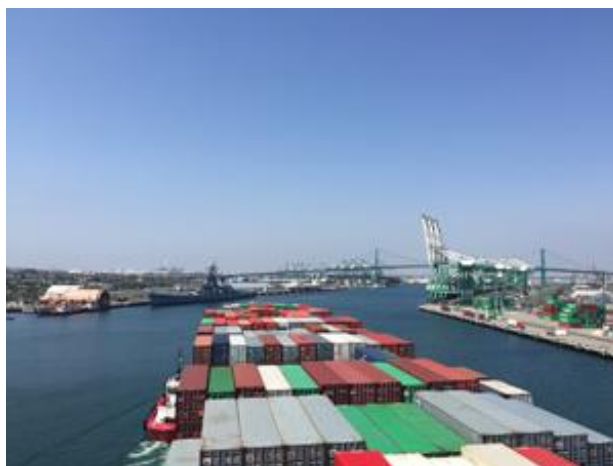

## MAYOR, PORT ANNOUNCE COMPLETION OF SOLAR PROJECT AT CRAFTED



Mayor Eric Garcetti joined Councilmember Joe Buscaino, the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) and the Port of Los Angeles' Executive Director Gene Seroka, to announce the completion of a 1.2-megawatt (MW) rooftop solar generation project at [CRAFTED at the Port of LA](#). The project is part of the City of Los Angeles' rooftop solar Feed-in Tariff (FiT) program, the largest of its kind in the nation. FiT enables building owners to host large-scale rooftop solar projects and sell the power they generate to LADWP for distribution on the City's power grid.

## DIRECT CONNECT TECHNOLOGY CAPTURES 100% OF SHIP EXHAUST



A typical day at the Port of LA: The 13,000-TEU vessel MSC Regulus, which was docked at APM Terminals' Pier 400 on February 19, used the [Advanced Maritime Emissions Control System \(AMECS\)](#), which reduces emissions while at berth. This "direct connect" technology safely connects to the vessel exhaust opening to provide 100% exhaust gas capture.
