IMPROVEMENTS TO BEGIN ON YUSEN TERMINAL



The Yusen container terminal improvement project consists of upgrading wharf and backland infrastructure within the terminal's existing footprint to enhance Yusen's ability to service the biggest ships in the trans-Pacific trade lanes. The improvements will allow Yusen to simultaneously work three container ships carrying up to 13,000, 11,000 and 6,500 Twenty-Foot Equivalent Units (TEUs) respectively and ensure cargo flows during peak periods when ships call at all three berths.
