AUGUST VOLUMES AT PORT OF LOS ANGELES ARE STRONGEST SINCE 2006



The Port of Los Angeles handled 798,932 Twenty-Foot Equivalent Units (TEUs) in August, its [busiest month](#) since 2006. It was the second busiest month in the Port's 109-year history, eclipsed only by October 2006, when the Port handled 800,063 TEUs. For the first eight months of 2016, year-to-date volumes have increased 4.3 percent compared to 2015.

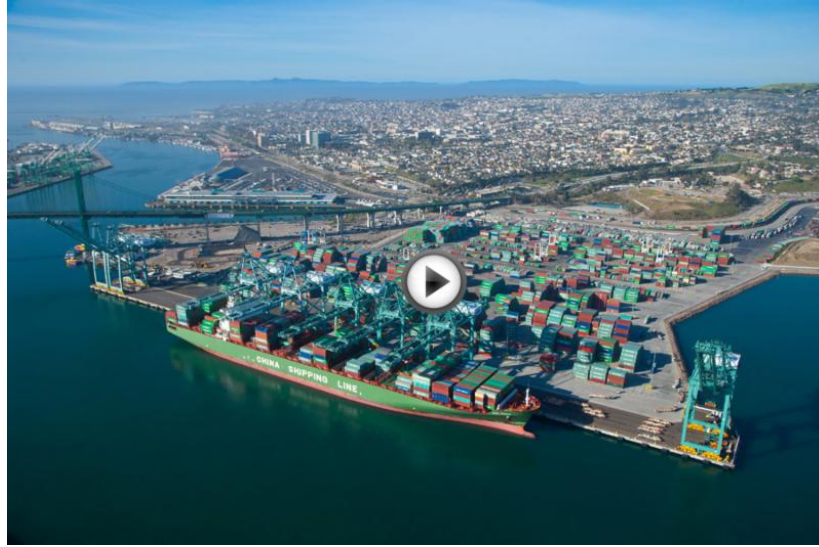
PORT ISSUES \$35.2 MILLION IN 'GREEN' BONDS



The Port of Los Angeles has expanded its commitment to sustainability by issuing \$35.2 million in green bonds as part of a larger debt refinancing successfully completed this week. The move marks the first time a U.S. port has entered the growing sustainability bond market where investors support projects and companies making positive social and environmental change.
