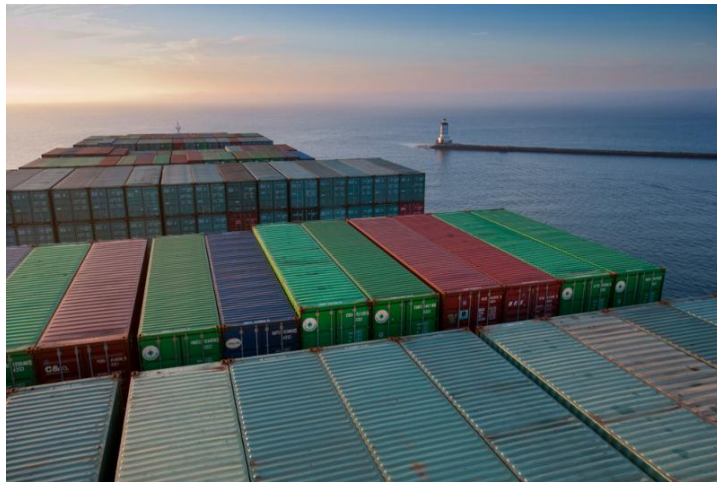

PORT OF LOS ANGELES MOVES 786,000 TEUs IN AUGUST; INCREASE OF 3.8% COMPARED TO 2014

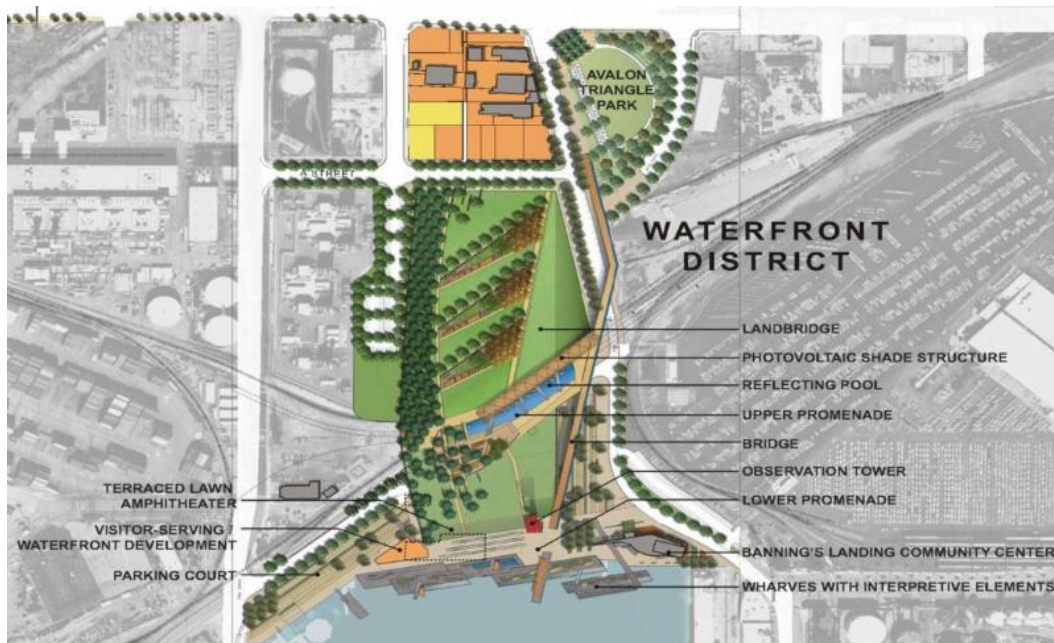


August container volumes were strong at the Port of Los Angeles, with more than 786,000 Twenty-Foot Equivalent Units (TEUs) passing through our wharves. WILMINGTON WATERFRONT MOVES FORWARD WITH PLANS FOR PLAZA, PROMENADE

The Port of Los Angeles is moving forward with \$3.2 million design contract with Sasaki Associates for a Wilmington Promenade on the LA Waterfront. The project includes a waterfront promenade, pedestrian plaza, realignment of Water Street adjacent to the railroad tracks, landscaping, and parking near Banning's Landing Community Center.
