CELEBRATING TEN YEARS OF CLEAN AIR AT THE PORT OF LA

Findings from its 10th consecutive year of tracking air pollution show the Port of Los Angeles has [set new records](#) for cutting harmful emissions from port-related sources, with diesel particulate matter (DPM) down an unprecedented 85 percent and sulfur oxides (SOx) bordering on total elimination, having plummeted 97 percent since 2005. The data also shows the Port has surpassed its 2014 emission reduction goals set in 2010 for DPM, SOx and nitrogen oxides (NOx).

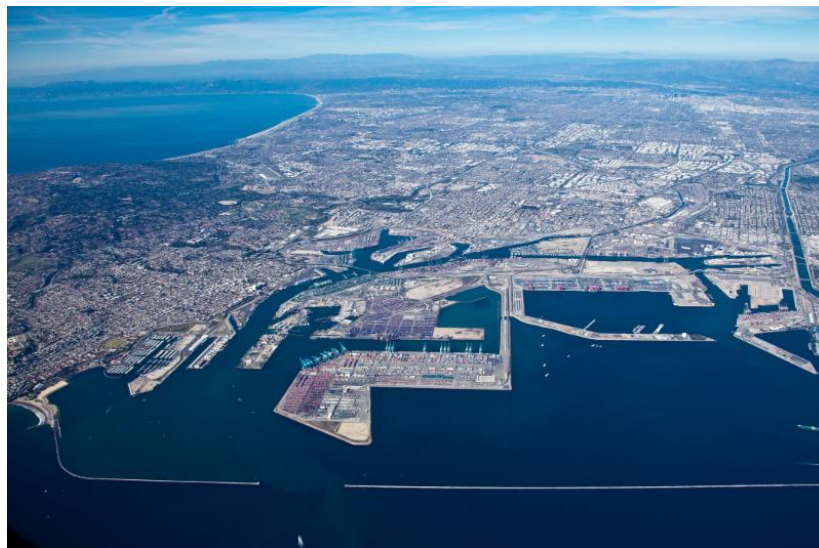
