METRO BIKE SHARE COMING TO THE PORT

Getting from place to place along the LA Waterfront is about to get a little easier - and a lot more fun. The Port of Los Angeles, in partnership with the [Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority \(Metro\)](#), has been given the green light by the LA Board of Harbor Commissioners to expand the Metro Bike Share program to the 12-mile LA Waterfront by next summer.



The LA Waterfront Bike Share will include 11 stations to start, eight in San Pedro and three in Wilmington, with approximately 10 shareable

bikes per station. Payment kiosks at each station will allow riders to use either their Metro TAP card or credit card to pay, with costs varying depending on the option selected.

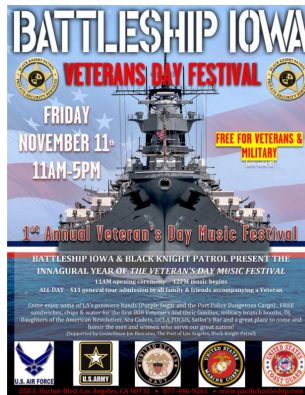
