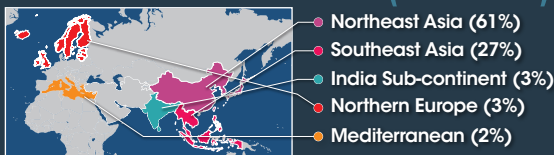

TOP 5 TRADE ROUTES (CY 2023)

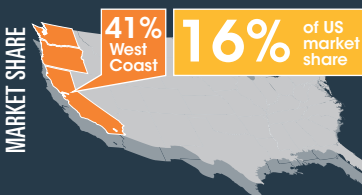

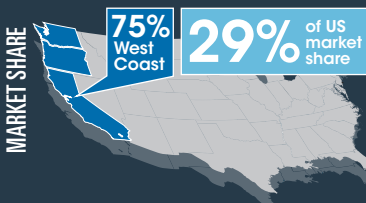
Port of Los Angeles
