“Most of my business comes from cruise ship crewmembers,” said Tiffany Becker, Owner and President of Breakfast at Tiffany’s. “I hope to see more cruise ship passengers and people walking along the Promenade as the word gets out, though.”

In addition to gourmet coffee and an espresso bar for specialty hot and ice-blended coffees, Breakfast at Tiffany’s offers decaf coffee and coffee alternatives, such as fruit smoothies and teas. Breakfast at Tiffany’s also offers a variety of assorted snacks to nosh, from danish and pound cake to cookies and fresh fruit, and other to-go goodies.

Breakfast at Tiffany’s hours of operation coincide with cruise ship schedules: Mondays and Fridays, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Breakfast at Tiffany’s offers a frequent buyer program and weekly specials.
