NEW SHUTTLE BUSES CONNECT THE WATERFRONT TO SAN PEDRO LANDMARKS INCLUDING CABRILLO BEACH

SAN PEDRO, Calif. – The DASH Bus route in San Pedro has been expanded to connect the Los Angeles Waterfront Red Car Line to the rest of San Pedro -- including downtown and Peck Park – all for only 25¢. In addition, a Cabrillo Beach Shuttle has been added to connect the 22nd Street Red Car Station to Cabrillo Beach. Both services replace the rubber-tired trolley routes previously serving these areas.

These shuttle services encourage visitors and locals to use public transportation to reach destinations in San Pedro instead of personal vehicles. With the new network of shuttles and the Red Cars, it is possible to “park once” and get to a variety of local landmarks. The cost is little: a ride on the Red Car is \$1, the DASH bus serving San Pedro is 25¢, and the Cabrillo Beach bus is free.

The Port of Los Angeles is subsidizing the free shuttle bus line to Cabrillo Beach at a cost of \$144,000 per year.
