PORT OF LOS ANGELES OFFERS FREE RED CAR RIDES DURING 5TH ANNUAL LOBSTER FESTIVAL

SAN PEDRO, CA – This year the Port of Los Angeles has added yet another amazing deal to its annual Lobster Festival at Ports O' Call Village: free rides on the Red Car! Visitors will take in a bit of nostalgia along the waterfront while enjoying tasty treats and entertainment during the entire three-day festival, September 19-21.

On Friday, September 19, the Red Car runs from 10 a.m. to 11 p.m. After 5 p.m., when the festival begins, the Red Car no longer visits the Cruise Center Station, but runs between the other three stations along the Harbor Boulevard route.

On Saturday, September 20, Red Car operation begins at 11 a.m. and runs continuously through all stations until 11 p.m.

On Sunday, September 21, the Red Car timetable again follows the Lobster Festival schedule, from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Throughout this unique and entertaining event, the regular \$1 Red Car fare is waived and tickets are transferable for free rides on San Pedro Electric Trolleys, connecting passengers to downtown San Pedro and Cabrillo Beach areas.

To ride the Red Cars and visit the Lobster Festival, take the 110 south and exit Harbor Boulevard, right. Free parking is available at Ports O' Call and at 22nd and Signal streets. Both locations are easily accessible to Red Car boarding stations.
