SUBJECT: WARREN REAPPOINTED TO HARBOR COMMISSION

SAN PEDRO (CA) – Los Angeles City Council members today confirmed the reappointment of Thomas H. Warren to the Harbor Commission. Warren's five year term will conclude in 2007.

First appointed to the Harbor Commission by Mayor James Hahn and confirmed by City Council in July 2001, Warren has over 35 years of waterfront experience in both terminal and vessel operations. A third-generation I.L.W.U. member, Warren is still active with the union.

The Los Angeles Board of Harbor Commissioners oversees the management and operations of the Port of Los Angeles, the busiest seaport in the United States. The five-member board is appointed by the Mayor of Los Angeles, subject to confirmation by the Los Angeles City Council. The commissioners serve alternating five-year terms.
